Sir,

The Department has received the pay-lists of the distribution of interest money for the spring of 1909 to the Indians of your Agency. You were sent \$350.00 wherewith to make the distribution. According to the pay-lists you paid out to members of the Henvey Inlet Band \$348.50, and you returned \$2.05 the share of No 82. Consequently you are entitled to 55¢, which is enclosed herewith by cheque No 1265.

In future if you have not enough pay-lists you should apply for them. It is observed that in this instance you used Robinson Treaty pay-lists, instead those intended for interest payments.
