Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th inst. enclosing a communication from Mr Public School Inspector McNeil on the subject of Provincial aid to Indian schools; and in reply I beg to inform you that although the Department did not take into consideration the question of a Provincial grant to Indian school teachers in Nova Scotia when fixing its salaries, it will, in view of the increased cost of living, pay the teacher of the Salmon River school at the rate of \$300.00 a year. This is all, however, that it is possible to do.
