



With reference to vouchers Nos. 2504 and 2519 amounting to \$40.00 each for work performed by Cad Pell as sawyer at the Hobbena Agency saw-mill, I beg to point out that the Department takes it for granted that the services of this <sup>workman</sup> ~~Indian~~ were discontinued on the date mentioned in voucher No. 2519, viz:- 23rd August as the estimated cost of having the 500 logs cut into timber and shingles was \$80.00 which amount has been paid by cheques Nos. 164 and 615.
