Sir,

I beg to enclose herewith for registration in the books of your Department a surrender made on the 10th April, 1909, by the Cold Lake band of Indians, of sixteen square miles of their reserve, known as the Cold Lake Indian reserve, No. 149, in Tps. 61 and 62, R. 3, W. of 4th M., with a view to exchanging the said sixteen square miles of their reserve for an equal area of Dominion land on the shore of Cold Lake, in Tps. 63 and 64, R. 2, W. of the 4th M.

The surrender was accepted by His Excellency in Council on the 11th January, 1911.

Kindly return the instrument to this Department as soon as possible, with a certificate of registration endorsed thereon.
