Sir,-

With reference to the concluding portion of your letter of the 7th July, I beg to say that you may engage a stenographer for one month to assist you in your office work. If you find it more convenient to employ the stenographer by the day at irregular intervals, the Department will pay for his services up to thirty days, provided the total cost does not exceed the charge for his continuous services for one month. The charge for the services required should not exceed the usual rate for stenographic work.

If the above arrangements will not meet the requirements of the work kindly advise the Department, and further authority will be granted.
