I have received a petition from the Council of the St. Regis Indians in favour of paying to Mrs. Oak the sum of \$100.00 which was granted to her daughter as compensation for her injury. A copy of this petition I am enclosing.

The Department does not consider that it would be possible to pay this money to any person other than the girl herself, and this only when she comes of age.

Will you be kind enough to advise the Council accordingly.
