posting thereof and a certificate of such posting purporting to be signed by a Selective Service Officer or Divisional Registrar shall be prime facie proof thereof.

- 702.(1) A certificate purporting to be signed by the Director or by any person authorized to act in the Director's place or on his behalf that any—thing has been done or omitted pursuant to or contrary to these regulations shall be evidence that such thing has been done or omitted.
- (2) A certificate purporting to be signed by the Director, an Associate Director, an Assistant Director, a Selective Service Officer or a Divisional Registrar that he has, pursuant to these regulations, served any document or caused any document to be served shall be evidence of the statements contained therein.
- person authorized to act in the Director's place or on his behalf that a document is a true copy of any other document which is or has been in the possession of the Entional Selective Service Department shall be evidence of the statements contained therein and the copy shall be accorded in all courts, the same probative force as the original document or part thereof, of which it is a copy.
- 703. In any proceeding for an alleged contravention of any of the provisions of these regulations, the burden of proving that the duty imposed by such prevision was not imposed on him and of proving that he has complied with all the requirements of these regulations shall be upon the person charged with such contravention.
- 704.(1) Every person is a party to and guilty of an effence under these regulations who
  - (a) actually commits it;
  - (b) does or omits an act for the purpose of aiding any person to commit the offence;
  - (c) abets any person in commission of the offence; or
  - (d) counsels or procures any person to commit the offence.
