CIRCULAR D. 87

Circular D. 87. Secret. My telegram
Circular D. 9, Secret, September 9. Admiralty have now
decided to allow inclusion of neutral vessels in British
convoys on the understanding that Admiralty accept no
responsibility for damage and subject to provisos that:

- (a) Ships are trading with or for
British Empire or France; and
- (b) No allied ship is thereby excluded.
