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Q-195. Was there enyone between you and Sgt Featherstone ? A-195. No, sir.

## Examined by the Court:

Q-196. Was Sgt Featherstone and Gnr McKinnon talking in loud voices as they come out? A-196. They seemed to be speaking a bit loud. Q-197. While you were standing in the doorway, did you see Sgt Featherstone A-197. No, sir. The Defence proceeds to call the next witness. 4th Witness for M-24309 Gnr Jones, L.G. having been duly sworn is the Defence. examined by the Defending Officer. Q-198. Gnr Jones, do you recognize the accused.? A-198. Yes, sir. Q-190. let, Bir. Q.199. Do you remember where you were on the night of 30 Oct? A-199. I was standing in the Cock Hotel, sir. Q-200. Do you remember seeing Gnr McKinnon in the Hotel? Q-200. Do you remember seeing our acting on acting on acting the noter.
A-200. Yes, sir.
Q-201. Were you with him at any time ?
A-201. Yes, sir, we walked to the Hotel and had a couple of drinks.
Q-202. And then what did you do?
A-2021 We were talking back and forth and an argument started and I didn't pay much attention. At first the Sgt was having a few drinks.
Q-203. Did Sgt Featherstone have anything to drink?
A-203. He had a glass in his hand, right hand.
Q-204. You were with McKinnon at that time ?
A-204. Until the argument then Sgt Featherstone took me out of the Pub. A-204. Until the argument then Sgt Featherstone took me out of the Pub. 2-205, Was Gnr McKinnon involved in the argument ? Q-205. Was Gnr Mokinnon Anterne. A-205. Yes, sir, he was with me. Q-206. What did he have to do with it, this argument in the Pub which resulted in you being put out of the Pub, what I mean is who was in this argument ? I was, sir A-206. Q-207. Was Gnr McKinnon, did he have any marks after that night? A-207. Yes, sir, the scar on the eyelid. Q-208. He didn t have that scar before ? A-208. No, sir. Defence: That is all, sir. Cross examined by the Prosecutor. Q-209. Did you come over to this country with this regiment ? A-209. No, sir. Q-210. How long have you known Gnr McKinnon ? A-210. 9 months, sir. Q-211. Have you been on any parties or entertainments with Gnr McKinnon ? A\_211. I have not been on any parties with him up to that time. Q-212. Wes Gnr Swallow drinking with you and Gnr McKinnon ? A\_212. He was in the same bar. Q-213. Did Gnr Swallow buy you any drinks ? A-213. No, sir. Q-214. Gnr McKinnon appeared the next morning to have a bruised right eye, is that true ? A-214. Yes, sir. Defence: No more questions, sir. With permission of the Court Sgt Featherstone is recalled and re-examined by the Prosecutor. Q-215. As the President of the Court said, you are still under oath, did you at any time on the evening of 30 Oct 42 partake of any alcoholic beaverages ? A-215. No, sir.
