

4.—ADMISSION OF MEMBERS.

The Society shall consist of the incorporators and promoters hereof, and all other persons who shall be admitted in the following manner:

5.—HOW ADMITTED.

Any person wishing to become a member must apply at the office of the Secretary-Treasurer, or other officer appointed, who shall furnish him with a form on which he must state his name, residence and occupation, and be proposed and seconded by two members of the Society. He must also, at the time of application, sign a declaration of his willingness to abide by the rules, pay an entrance fee of 25 cents, and take out from one to twenty-five shares of one dollar each. He shall be furnished with a copy of the rules. Complete list of names, residences and occupation of all persons who have applied to become members in the manner hereinbefore stated, shall be submitted to the next meeting of the Committee of Management for their approval, and if any person whose name is on the list shall be objected to by a majority of the Committee of Management then present, the name of the said person shall be erased from the list. All persons objected to by either the Committee of Management or the members at the next quarterly meeting when the application for membership comes up, shall have the whole of the money which they shall have paid into the Society returned.
