### Synopsis of Canadian North-West.

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

Ny even-numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manifoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta, excepting 8 and 35, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 15 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 159 acres, more or lega.

Application for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district in which the land is stuate. Entry by proxy, may, however, he made at any Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister of an intending homesteader.

DUTIES.—(I) At least sfx months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if so desires, perform the requir residence duties by living farming land owned solely him, not less than eighty (80) act in extent, in the vicinity of homestead. He may also do so living with father or mother, certain conditions. Joint ownership in land will not meet this quirement. his by

(3) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself must notify the agent for the district of such intention.
