

EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM.

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The pupil's health, religious training, mental culture, and high moral tone are points of constant and earnest solicitude.

The studies of the school are regulated with a view to thoroughness and gradual progress ; no more being attempted at any time in each several branch than can be obtained with satisfaction and profit.

At the end of the Summer Term there is a general examination into the whole work of the year, and prizes are awarded to all those whose answering deserves 75 per cent. This method of giving prizes affords an opportunity to each pupil of gaining some honor as proof of exertion.

A medal is awarded by "The Alliance Francaise, Paris," to the pupil who speaks French the best.

French is the habitual language of the family.

Reports of the conduct and work of the pupils are sent home at the close of each term.

Every 1st Thursday of the month there is a Musical and Literary Evening, when the pupils play, sing, read and recite.

REGULATIONS.

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Leave of absence during the session is granted only on special grounds, which should be stated in a written application to the principal.

Parents and guardians wishing to visit the pupils are requested to select Saturday afternoon.

Pupils residing in town will be allowed to visit on Saturdays those friends whom the parents designate ; provided those friends accompany them to and from the school.

No reduction will be made for absence or for withdrawal of a pupil before the end of the term, except in case of illness.

All damages must be repaired at the expense of the pupil by whom it has been caused.
