

An Act to explain an Act made and passed in the 33d Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitl'd, An Act to enable Proprietors to divide their Lands held in common and undivided.

HERE AS in the second Clause of the said Act it is set forth, That at the first Meets g of the Proprietors of any common Lands, the said Proprietors shall agree upon and appoint any other Way and Method of calling and summoning Meetings for the future, as shall be most suitable and convenient to the Proprietors: And Whereas some Doubts have arisen, whether such subsequent Meetings should be within the County or Township where such Lands lie, or without?

It is hereby enacted and declared by his Excellency the Governor, Council and Assembly, That it was and is the Intention of the Legislature, that all Meetings or Proprietors relating to the Division of Lands; or any other matter relative thereto, shall be held within the County where such Lands lie, unless such Meeting shall be agreed to be held in any other County in the Province, by a Majority of the Proprietors Resident in the same.

An Act in Amendment of an Act, intitl'd, An Act for confirming Titles to Lands and Quieting Possessions.

HERE AS some Inconveniences have already and frequently may arise to the Purchasers of Lands in this Province, from the Difficulty of producing, before the Register or his Deputy, one of the Witnesses to the Execution of any Deed or Conveyance brought by them to be registred, either from such Deed or Conveyance having been executed in Great-Britain or Ireland, or in some of His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations distant from this Province, in the Presence of Witnesses resident there, who cannot be produced before the said Register or his Deputy, to prove the Execution thereof on Oath, thereby preventing the due Registring of such Deed or Conveyance, agreeable to the Directions of an Act made and passed by the Governor, Council, and Assembly of this Province, in the 32d Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitl'd, An Act for confirming Titles to Lands and quieting Possessions: For Remedy where-
