WASTAGE 11,211 IN HALF MONTH

Exceeds Total of Recruits Obtained in That Time by 9,150.

CASUALTIES ARE 8,252 Total Wastage of Infantrymen in 15 Days was 8,498—Enlistments 896.

Ottawa, Nov. 30—A statement issued by the War Department shows that during the first fifteen days of the present month the total wastage in the Canadian Expeditionary Force exceeded the total number of recruits obtained by 9,150 men.

Casualties overseas for the fifteen-day period were very heavy, a total of 8,252 men being placed in this class. Of this number, 6,448 were infantrymen.
