GLITTER AND GOLD FOR COURT SEASON

Gay Colors Fashionable Once More as Well as Jewel Embroideries.

London, April 28.—The first court of the season is only a few weeks distant, and "What shall I wear when I go to Buckingham Palace?" is the question that every woman who hopes to be honored with an invitation to attend is asking herself.

Gay colors are fashionable once more; the artists in dress materials have been busy evolving fresh and lovely fabrics; jewel embroideries are gorgeous beyond any that ever adorned the robes of the Queen of Sheba; Nottingham has never made more beautiful lace to deck the person of lovely woman.

Dresses that sparkle, dresses that glow, dresses characterized by Grecian draperies, stunnerous gowns, medieval gowns, a woman may choose any one of these styles, and still be modern.
As to new colors and materials, there is a lovely shade of pale apricot shot with pink, an exquisite shade known as water blue, a new tint in cream mauve, and some gorgeous moiré fabrics, the way-like pattern on which is indicated by fine gold or silver thread.

Side by side with jewel embroidery, there are marvellous trimmings composed of ostrich feathers, sweeping tassels that almost for a train at one side of the gown to which they are attached, greatly dainty, collar that almost form a cape about the neck (which may be of silver or golden material) to which they are attached, soft delicate bands that appear in tiers on the skirts of debutantes' gowns, tufts that decorate court trains are all to be found on smart gowns of the moment.

One white court gown showed a corsage embroidered with large diamond paillettes, others are literally showered with light in the form of strands of crystals producing an extraordinarily beautiful effect.
One of the loveliest court dresses is of orange satin sewn with lozenge-shaped diamond motifs with a train of orange and gold moiré that served as a background for Byzantine embroidery, the huge half pearls and crystal and topaz paillettes used in which gave the whole an Arabian's cave kind of magnificence that was more than a little striking.

Another train of coral and gold moiré was enriched with green and pink pearls and blue and gold paillettes, and yet another of fine parchment tulle was sewn closely with shimmering paillettes, each of which was a tiny jewel.
