SYMBOL OF SACRIFICE. The burning incense is, in the first place, a symbol of sacrifice for as incense is consumed in the re, so should man's entire faculties be consumed in the fire of divine love. In the second place, incense, with its cloud of smoke lizes prayer. It reminds us that our prayers ought to ascend to heaven as the clouds of incense rise in the air. Hence the Royal Prophet beautifully says: "Let my prayer be directed as incense in Thy sight, O Lord." (Psalm CXLII.) Thirdly, the odor incense is a symbol of divine grace. For, just as our prayers and sacrifices ascend to God like the smoke of burning incense, so heir agreeable spiritual odor draws down His blessings upon us. Hence the Church at the Offertory of Solemn High Mass in incensing the bread and wine " May this incense which Thou hast blessed, O Lord, ascend to Thee, and may Thy mercy descend upon us.
