### Assert Allies Seek to Eliminate Kaiser

Dr. Morton Prince Declare Terms, Not per their purpose."-N. Y. Times. Given to Wilson, Include Wilhelm's Downfall.

not give to President Wilson provide for the literal elimination of the Kaiser as the absolute ruler of Germany, according to Dr. Morton Prince of Boston, who said in an address under the auspices of the American Fund for French Wounded at the Old Colony Club Building yesterday afternoon that "The German Kaiser the felon and bully of Europe, must go." He declared that President Wilson did not represent the attitude of the American people when he said that the United States was not concerned in the causes or aims of the war.

Dr. Prince, who is an uncle of Norman Prince, killed while serving as an aviator for France, said that this country had much at stake because the theory of government back of those fighting the Kaiser was the same as that on which this Government was German militarism must be crushed. or the battle would have to be fought all over again, he gave as the motive for their determination not to make peace until the Kaiser and what he stood for were in the dust. He pre dicted exile for the Kaiser or establishment in Germany of a democratic Government that would destroy Wilhelm's autocratic power.
