A Casino Proposed for British Cemetery at Corfu.

Athens, July 2.—British residents of Greece are much wrought up over the action of the Government in accepting the offer of a foreign capitalist to erect a gambling casino in the old British cemetery in Corfu. When the Ionian Islands were ceded by England to Greece in 1861, it was specifically provided that the cemeteries would remain undisturbed. The new scheme includes a hydropathic institution, concert hall and casino, where a full "lay-out" will be run after the fashion of Monte Carlo.
