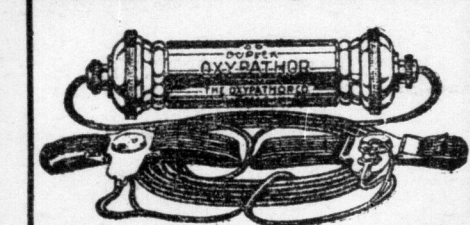

## BOOSTS CAUSE OF EDUCATION HERE

**R. A. Little, Former Vice-Principal of Collegiate, Back on Visit.**

### HEADS COAST HIGH SCHOOL

Declares Modern Buildings Are Necessary in March of Educational Ideas.

R. A. Little, former vice-principal of the Collegiate Institute, arrived in London yesterday afternoon as the advance guard of the Vancouver Old Boys. Mr. Little is almost a militant westerner. Although he has only been here two years, he wouldn't live anywhere else. He says the times are quiet just now, and it is a bit dull in Vancouver, but like other westerners, he believes in the old saying that "every cloud has a silver lining."

Is High School Principal.  
Mr. Little is principal of the Duke of Connaught High School, at New Westminster. For a year after leaving London he was principal of the King Edward High School in Vancouver. The Duke of Connaught High School was only recently completed to accommodate 400 pupils. It has sixteen rooms, and has not yet been formally opened.

Building Many Schools.  
"They are building the finest schools in the country out west," declared Mr. Little. "and they regard money spent on education as well spent. The buildings for the most part are new and up-to-date, and the people show a great interest in the work of advancing the cause of education."

Mr. Little's attention was called to the fact that London contemplates the building of one new school, and the improvement of others. He said this was a good sign, and ought not to have much opposition, as modern buildings and appliances were necessary if London was to keep abreast with the march of education.

Many Londoners in West.  
"Vancouver is full of Londoners," said Mr. Little. "and they were making arrangements to send a crowd of old boys to the reunion just as I left. I will be here for two weeks renewing old acquaintances and visiting relatives. I must return to my position by August 1."

New Thing in Schools.  
"The newest thing in school building," he said, "is a long building with wide central hall, and the rooms arranged on either side of it. Our new high school is only two stories high. I haven't seen the one-story building as yet, but I understand there are some being built. There are none in the west that I know of."
