The first day will be devoted to the Ontario and Dominion Alliance meetings, then follow the World League sessions.

It is expected that the World League convention will be attended by representatives from more than fifty nations, including those of Europe, India, Australia, the Orient, Africa, South America, Francisco

outh America, Egypt and the West The convention will be open to all those in sympathy with the world-wide prohibition movement.

men of international repute will address the gatherings, which doubtless will more than fill Massey Hall at all the sessions of the World League convention. Lief Jones of York, England, and Dr. Howard H. Russell of Wester ville, Ohio.




