## ARGO'S FIRST HEAT BY A BARE LENGTH

Canadian Crew Defeats First Trinity Grand Challenge Preliminary

Henley, Eng., July 2.—The Argonauts of Canada beat First Trinity, Cambridge, today in the first heat for the Grand Challenge cup. The Argonauts won, after a magnificent race, by a bare length. Time, 7 minutes and 30 seconds. The Canadians, who had the Bucks station, went off with a lively stroke of 4 to the minute and drew away immediately. First Trinity hung on doggedly, but were a length and a half behind at Fawley Court, which was reached in 3 minutes and 20 seconds. Here the Cambridge crew spurred and recovered some of the intervening distance, but although First Trinity spurred again and again they were unable to get their boat's nose beyond the stern of the visitors' shell.

Referee Pittman, speaking to the Canadian Press regarding the heat, said he thought the Argos rowed a fine race, but they yet had some hard work before them. It is claimed that Walsh and Kent of the Argos were about played out at Fawley Court, but they were not. The Argonauts when seen at the boat-house did not seem in any way dis-tressed, they declared they felt no effect of the hard row. English scullers are very liberal in their praise of the Argonauts, whose win is certainly a very popular one. Third Trinity acknowledged to the Canadian Press that their crew were almost out at the finish. Fletcher, of the Leanders, and Stewart, of the general committee, said the win was what they had expected.

In the preliminary heat for the Diamond scull, which was rowed by Adam, of Australia, beat W. B. West, of Philadelphia, by 3/4 lengths.

West went off with 25 strokes to the minute and told for a quarter of a mile, but Adam then wore him down and won easily in the slow time of 5 minutes and 21 seconds.
