

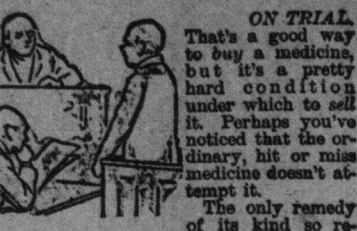
TRINITY CHURCH JUBILEE
