Twenty-Second Annual Meeting.

The Twenty-second Annual Meeting was held in the offices of the Company, 103 Bay-street, Toronto, on Wednesday, the 8th day of October, 1895, at noon.

The following report was adopted: The Directors beg to submit the Twenty-second Annual Report of the Company, together with accounts for the year ending 31st August, 1895.

Applications for loans were received during the year to the amount of \$1,232,222 on property estimated as worth \$1,780,978, and loans were approved and advanced to the extent of \$298,332.09 on property valued by the company's own appraisers at \$464,870.

While the amount of Debentures and Certificates issued was \$96,908.16, making an increase of \$96,755.69 since last report.

The revenue account, after all interest and charges have been deducted, and all ascertained losses written off, shows a balance of \$61,427.47.

There remains a balance of \$4,524.29 which is carried forward as the credit of "Revenue Account" to next year.

A committee of the Board was appointed to investigate and revise the securities of the company, and to materially effect a reduction of the real estate.

The result of their labors, extending over a period of some months, has decided the Board to set aside the sum of \$210,000 out of the "Reserve Fund."

It will be observed that the issue of \$100,000 Debenture Stock has been nearly all taken up.

Since last annual meeting the Company has been deprived of the services of its chief and faithful Director by the death of Mr. C. E. Hooper.

His place has been filled by the appointment of Mr. Thomas Long, of the firm of Messrs. Thomas Long & Co., of Collingwood.

He has a large interest in the company and his high standing and business experience will be of great value to the Company.


