Bordeaux mixture is by far the preferable material to use on po tatoes. When forest trees are ripe they should be cut and put to some use as quickly as possible There is no more virtue in keeping a forest till it is over-ripe than in keeping a field of wheat uncut when it is fit for the reaper. Until a forest is ready for the saw it should be protected, and when cut down the soil on which it stood, if not fit for agriculture, should be left in shape for the immediate starting of another crop of trees.
