

# ST. LAWRENCE CANALS

#### NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS.

Sealed tenders addressed to the undersigned and endorsed "Tender for the St. Lawrence Canal," will be received at this office until the arrival of the satern and western mails on Tuesday, the 25th day of September next, for the construction of two locks, and the deepening and enlargement of the upper entrance of the Galops Canal, and for the deepening and enlargement of the summit level of the Cornwall Canal. The construction of a new lock at each of the three interior lock stations on the Cornwall canal, between the Town of Cornwall and Maple Grove; the deepening and widening the channel way of the canal; construction of bridges, &c.

A map of each of the localities together with plans

A map of each of the localities together with plant and specifications of the respective works, can be seen on and after Tuesday, the 11th day of September, next, at this office for all the works, and of the respective works at the following mentioned labors:

For the works at Galops, at the Lock-keeper's louse Galops. For deepening the summit level of the Cornwall Canal, at Dickenson's Landing; and or the new locks, &c., at lock-stations Nos. 18, 19 and 1, at the Town of Cornwall. Printed forms of tender can be obtained for the respective works at the places mentioned.


