closed for repairs and several of our flights had to be diverted to Novosibirsk. However, no one made any advance arrangements about refreshments. As a result both passengers and aircrews flew out of Novosibirsk hungry. And the situation won't be dealt with in a hurry, since to do anyting requires both an order from Moscow and a greater degree of understanding with the local enterprises. All of that takes time.
