Current U.S. tariffs on machinery for finishing paper or paperboard and for parts of paper machinery range from 3% to 4.7%. Under the Free Trade Agreement, these tariffs will be reduced in 5 equal stages to reach duty-free status by January 1, 1993.

Current U.S. tariffs on personal accessories range from 3.7% to 15.5%. Under the Free Trade Agreement, these items become duty free by January 1, 1998 with ten equal stages of reductions.
