If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of Canada, I have to suggest that this Letter, together with its Annex, and your reply to that effect, shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on this day's date and shall be terminable in the circumstances envisaged in paragraph 12 or by either Government giving not less than four months' notice in writing to the other.
