PRAYERS

One petition for a Private Bill was presented in accordance with Standing Order 67(1).

Mr. Blaker, from the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections, presented the First Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference dated Thursday, November 14, 1974, your Committee has considered Bill C-214, An Act to amend the Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act, and has agreed to report it with the following amendment:

Clause 1

Strike out lines 17 to 19 and substitute the following therefor:

"(c) "report" means a report of a commission and any newspaper advertisement published under subsection 17(3), and in the Canada Gazette as required pursuant to the provisions of this Act, and the recommendations therein set forth;"

Your Committee has ordered a reprint of Bill C-214, as amended, for the use of the House of Commons at the report stage.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to this Bill (Issue No. 1) is tabled.
