

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 54.

An Act to amend The Reinstatement in Civil
Employment Act, 1942.

1942-43, c. 31. HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the
Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as
follows:—

1. *The Reinstatement in Civil Employment Act, 1942*,
chapter thirty-one of the statutes of 1942-43, is amended by 5
adding thereto the following section:—

Orders in
Council
given force
and effect
of Act of
Parliament.

“12. The Orders of the Governor in Council set out in
the Schedule to this Act have the same force and effect,
on and from the days on which they were respectively
made, as if they have been enacted by Parliament.” 10

2. The said Act is further amended by adding thereto
the following Schedule:—
