1 February 16—That a Select Committee be appointed to investigate and report upon the feasibility of, and the advantages which would accrue to the Dominion from the construction of a canal uniting the waters of Lake Huron with those of the St. Lawrence via the Ottawa River, the said Committee to consist of the Honourable Messieurs Sir Mackenzie Bowell, Scott, Casgrain, McMillan, Dobson, Bellerose, De Boucherville, Ogilvie, Owens, Almon, Miller, McKay, Power, Bernier, Boulton, Perley, Macdonald (P.E.I.), Prowse, Reid, and the mover ; with power to send for papers, persons and records, and to employ such persons as the Committee may deem necessary for the purpose of the investigation, and to report from time to time.
