

# CONSTITUTION

OF THE

## MONTREAL HOMŒOPATHIC ASSOCIATION.

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I. The affairs of this Association shall be managed by a Board of Ten Directors, who shall be annually elected by ballot on the first Monday of December.

II. The Board of Directors shall appoint a President, a Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer from among themselves.

III. The Board shall meet immediately after the Annual Meeting of the Association, and on the third Monday of March, June, September and November, and at other times when called by the Secretary at the request of the President or not fewer than two Directors. Five Directors shall form a quorum for the transaction of business.

IV. The Directors shall have power to fill vacancies on the Board occurring during their term of office.

V. The Board of Directors shall have full power to act according to Sections 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12 and 13 of this Act, or any other part or amendments thereof.

VI. The retiring Board of Directors shall present a report to the Association at the Annual Meeting.

VII. Any person desiring to become a member of the Association shall, on giving notice to the Secretary, be balloted for at the next meeting of Directors.

VIII. The membership fee shall be \$2, payable annually.

IX. The Constitution may be amended at an Annual Meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, such amendment having been inserted in the notice of the annual meeting; but no amendment shall ever be admitted which tends to alter the character of the Association as distinctively Homœopathic.

X. The Board shall have the power to make By-Laws as may be necessary for the Association.
