This is What You Can See:

1st Morning.—Goat Island and Prospect
Park on foot.

Afternoon.—Ride to Canada side, Dufferin
Islands, and panoramic view from hill back
of Clifton House.

2d Morning.—Excursion on observation
train of New York Central and Hudson River
Railroad to Lewiston, giving view of the Niag-
ara Gorge, rapids and whirlpool below the Falls.

Afternoon.—Sail in "Maid of the Mist,"
giving a grand view of the Falls from below.

If a third day is taken one may visit the
"Cave of the Winds" under the Falls, take a
trip to Niagara-on-the-Lake, Brock's Monu-
