An account has been submitted from Joseph Doust against the Clerk of the Pesce for Magistrates' biank forms amounting to \$97.04. The prices charged for these forms are high but as payment would in the end have to be made by the County your committee recommend that the amount be paid.

Your committee recommend that an allowance of ten dollars be made to the Local Registrar of the High Court of Justice for stationery for his office during the present year.

Your committee approve of the action of the County Cierk in taking charge of the Magistrates' blank forms purchased by the Cierk of the Peace and would recommend that he be instructed to procure a list of the the qualified magistrates of the judicial county, in which list the Cierk of the Peace should be requested to note the names of those Magistrates who are known as acting Magistrates and who therefore are entitled to have forms supplied to them.

• Your committee recommend that the County Cierk be instructed to procure, under the direction of the County Judge, a supply of forms for use under the provisions of the Ontario Voters' Lists Act to be supplied to the Cierks of local Municipalities.

## PETITION.

## TO THE HONORABLE THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE PRO. VINCE OF ONTARIO IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED.

The Petition of the Municipal Council of the Coaporation of the County of Victoria: HUMBLY SHEWETH,-

1 That on the petition of certain of the inhabitants of the Township of Harvey in the County of Peterborough an Act was passed in the year 1879 (42 Vic. Cap. 47) whereby all that portion of the said Township, consisting of all lots in the Nineteenth Concession from lots One to Fifteen inclusive (torming a narrow strip of land on the West side of Pigeon Lake) was detached from the Township of Havey and annexed to the Township of Verulam in the County of Victoria.

2 The Corporation of the County of Victoria was no party to the passing of the said Act, but the same was passed wholiy for the benefit and convenience of the inhabitants of the said Township of Harvey.
