

*Standing*

Chair, the Minutes of the preceding day shall be read by the Clerk, to the end that any mistake therein may be corrected.

4.

That the Warden shall preserve order and decorum, and shall decide questions of order, subject to an appeal to the Council.

5.

That every Councillor previous to his speaking, shall rise from his seat, and address himself to the Warden.

6.

That when a Councillor is speaking, no other Member of the Council shall hold discourse to interrupt him.

7.

That a Councillor called to order by the Warden shall sit down, unless permitted to explain, and

when two or more shall speak at once, the presiding (Speaker) of the Council, shall name the Member who shall speak.

That no Councillor shall speak more than once in a session, without the leave of the Council, except the Speaker, who shall have a right to speak.

That upon any question in debate, of those who vote against the motion, who vote against shall be entered in the Minutes, if any Councillor shall so require.

That no question shall be debated or put to a vote, unless it be first introduced in writing and read.
