INSANITY AND CRIME

Every one knows that there is a certain relation or connection between insanity and crime: few have any clear notion what the relation or connection precisely is. common knowledge that crime is often committed by insane persons; and it is widely known that many persons convicted of crime are found, after conviction, to be feeble or disordered in mind; though this feebleness or disorder was not suspected, or was not taken into account, when they were charged and convicted of crime. There are some who regard crime as, ipso facto, evidence, or even proof, of insanity in the criminal; and others, without going to this extreme, yet regard some crimes, murder for instance, as conclusive proof that the criminal was insane
