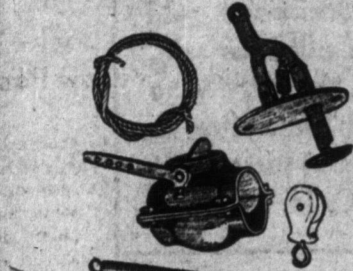

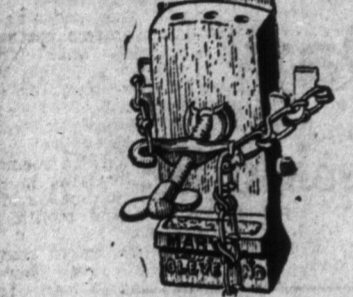
Noteworthy Suggestions and Values in Auto Accessories

By repairing small cuts in tire, many additional miles may be secured. Can also be used for repairing inner tubes.

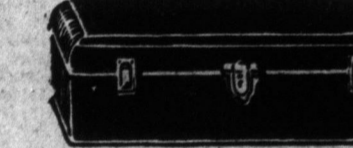
