Discussing the question of state ownership, Mr. Borden said that in North America state ownership of railways has not made a strong precedent and we were therefore apt to overlook the fact that outside of North America and the British Empire, the rule and private ownership of the railway mileage owned by private corporations is \$7,334, and by various governments \$2,635,000,000.

Mr. Fielding gave the house the particulars of the Grand Trunk's original proposition for a railway from Montreal and Quebec, a country affording comparatively little local traffic, and besides, it had to contend with splendid waterways not only in that district but in the Maritime Provinces as a whole.

Mr. Fielding gave it as a liberal estimate that the cost of the railway would be \$44,125,000, or ten and three-quarter millions less than Mr. Borden's estimate. Interest on the \$44,125,000, capitalized, making a total of \$71,150,000 for the entire railway.
