## EXPECT RADICAL CHANGE IN TAX MEASURES SOON

Ottawa Predicts Next Budget Will Remove Excess Profits Law.

IS NOT VOTE-GETTER

Therefore Luxury Tax Will Likely Be Abolished by Meighen Regime.

(Special to The Advertiser.) OTTAWA, Oct. 6.—Radical changes in the existing direct federal taxes are anticipated for the next budget of the finance minister. In the course of its peregrinations so far the tariff commission has had but few suggestions as to new or improved taxation measures. The Single Tax Association of Western Canada has suggested that the present customs duties can be heavily cut and that the revenue lost thereby can be made up by the imposition of a tax of 2 per cent on unimproved land values. This suggestion, it is safe to predict, will not be adopted by the present Government. The Grain Growers have declared that \$200,000,000 could be collected from incomes if the act were properly enforced. In recent months there are indications of greater collecting activity on the part of the commissioner of taxation.

**Believed Premonition.** This increased activity is taken here as a premonition of the abolition next session of the excess profits tax, which has in any case never been popular with the Government or with its friends. During the war, when it might have been expected to bring a very considerable amount to the treasury, it brought little more than \$35,000,000. Now that the war is over it is contended that it simply constitutes a discouragement to industry and production. It is claimed that the company which has a bonafide capitalization under its provisions has been heavily penalized, while the company with watered stock has gone comparatively free. The disappearance of this tax next session may safely be predicted, although in Great Britain it was increased by the last budget. The sales or turnover tax, which can be passed on to the public, will take its place.

**Formidable Dose.** A somewhat formidable dose of direct taxes, in the shape of the luxury tax, was administered to the public last session. It is now rumored that these may be removed and that the sales tax will take their place. That tax is 1 per cent on the turnover of manufacturers and importers. It is easily collected, and though passed on to the public, is not noticed by the average purchaser, because no invoice is supplied. The luxury tax is not a vote-getter in any case, and votes are what the Government wants at the next election. In justification of its probable removal it is contended that one of its designs, namely, to encourage thrift, has not really materialized. It is further contended that if the cost of living decreases it will not be a revenue-getter and will cost more than it is worth to administer. It is anticipated that so far as the finance minister is concerned the Government will make its bid to the electorate upon a system of taxation as indirect as possible and whose one direct feature will be the income tax.

**CHANGES PROBABLE.** OTTAWA, Oct. 6.—The Citizen, in its two columns today, says: "There is a strong probability that the coming session of Parliament will see considerable variation in the tax measures of the Government. 'The business profits tax is likely to go, and possibly the luxury tax may be replaced by the sales tax. There is also talk, but less of it, of modifying the luxury tax.'

## ONTARIO'S SUPPLY OF PULP WILL LAST 60 YEARS, ESTIMATE

Montreal Speaker Urges Measures To Deal With Situation.

Toronto, Oct. 6.—Many problems of vital interest to the trade were discussed at the third annual convention of the Canadian Paper Trade Association here today. At a banquet tonight Edward Beck of Montreal spoke on "The Pulp and Paper Industry of Canada." He prophesied that if the present course was pursued in the province of Ontario the supply would be used up within 30 or 40 years. He regarded the question as vital and requiring immediate attention. Referring to the necessity of Canada obtaining a revenue that would result in lessening the debt of war, Mr. Beck said that Canadian raw material must be kept available for home manufacture and means must be adopted to insure their permanent supply. W. Graham of Hamilton, Ont., was elected president of the association, and E. S. Munro, Toronto, secretary. The convention will be in session again tomorrow.

## MEDICAL ACADEMY TO MAKE STATEMENT ABOUT CANCER CURE

Toronto, Oct. 6.—An authoritative statement as to the cancer serum discovered by Dr. T. J. Glover of this city will be forthcoming by the end of this month, according to an announcement made here tonight by the council of the Toronto Academy of Medicine, which met today and considered the matter at some length. Dr. H. Elliott, president of the academy, issued the following statement as to Dr. Glover's cancer cure: "The results are not satisfactory. A statement to this effect will be published." The council of the academy, named by the academy as a committee of inquiry into the claims of Dr. Glover as to the efficacy of his treatment for cancer, made arrangements today to hear a personal presentation or have a written communication from Dr. Glover on the question. In the meantime, judgment thereon will be withheld by the local physicians as a body.

## HUGHES GETS FIVE YEARS FOR THEFT

VICTORIA, B. C., Oct. 6.—Griffith R. Hughes, prominent newspaperman, pleaded guilty to the charge of stealing \$38,000 from the David Spencer department store, for which he was sentenced to five years in the penitentiary, when he was brought before Mr. Justice Morrison in the supreme court today. The sentence is five years on each count of seven indictments, but they are to run concurrently. Hughes took the sentence calmly.

## MEXICANS KILL TWO, HOLD HOUSE UNDER FIRE OF PATROLMEN

Pittsburg Laborers Barricade Themselves in Boarding-House.

Pittsburg, Oct. 6.—After killing a patrolman and a resident of a crowd of Mexican laborers, armed with pistols, barricaded themselves in a boarding-house at Homestead, a suburb, tonight, and are engaging a posse of police and firemen in an exchange of shots. The Mexicans, according to the police, were acting in a disorderly manner on the street, when two patrolmen tried to arrest them. One of the Mexicans produced a pistol and killed Patrolman William Smith, and wounded Patrolman Henry Davis. The crowd then returned to a Mexican boarding-house, where they shot and killed the proprietor, and barricaded themselves in. The police found it impossible to break into the house, due to the constant fire from the Mexicans. The fire department was called out, and shortly after 10 o'clock the firemen were laying several lines of hose, with the intention of directing the streams into the boarding-house windows.

**DEPUTY SHERIFF KILLED.** CHARLESTON, W. VA., Oct. 6.—Joseph Gore, a deputy sheriff, was killed, three other persons were seriously wounded, and two miners were shot in a fight early tonight at Blair, Logan County, West Virginia, on Little Coal River, according to information received here by Fred Mooney, secretary of District No. 17, United Mine Workers of America. The trouble is said to have started when deputy sheriffs interrupted a meeting of the United Mine Workers.

## NORTH BAY POLICE SEEK "TED" JOHNSON

North Bay, Oct. 6.—Chief of Police Rayner tonight received a telegram from Provincial Constable Harold Norton at Gowanda, Ont., requesting him to seek Johnson. "Ted" Johnson, who was wanted in the silver camp on a charge of shooting his sister, and who was also wanted in connection with the shooting of a man on a southbound train, was seen at Allen Hotel, Bay City, Mich. 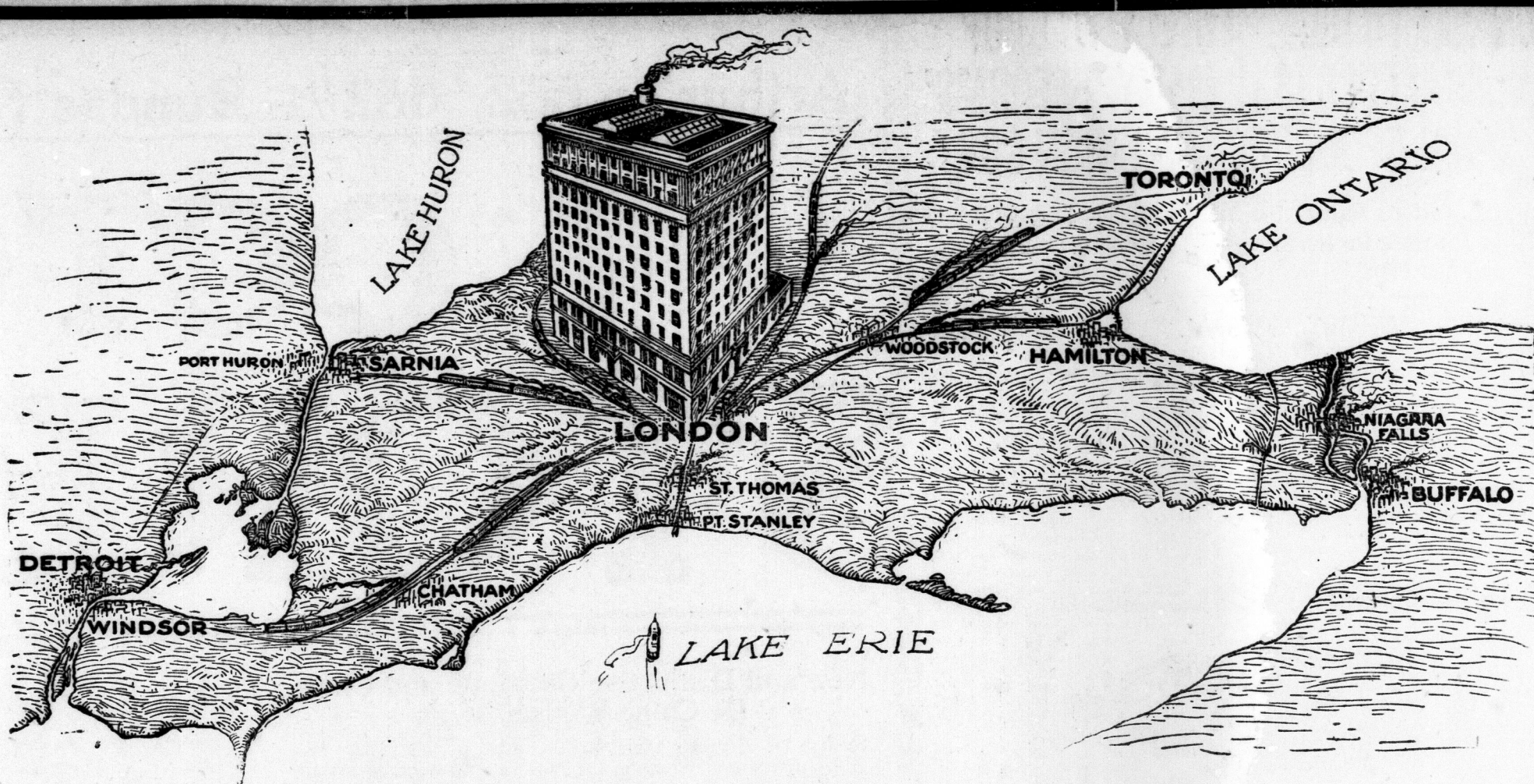

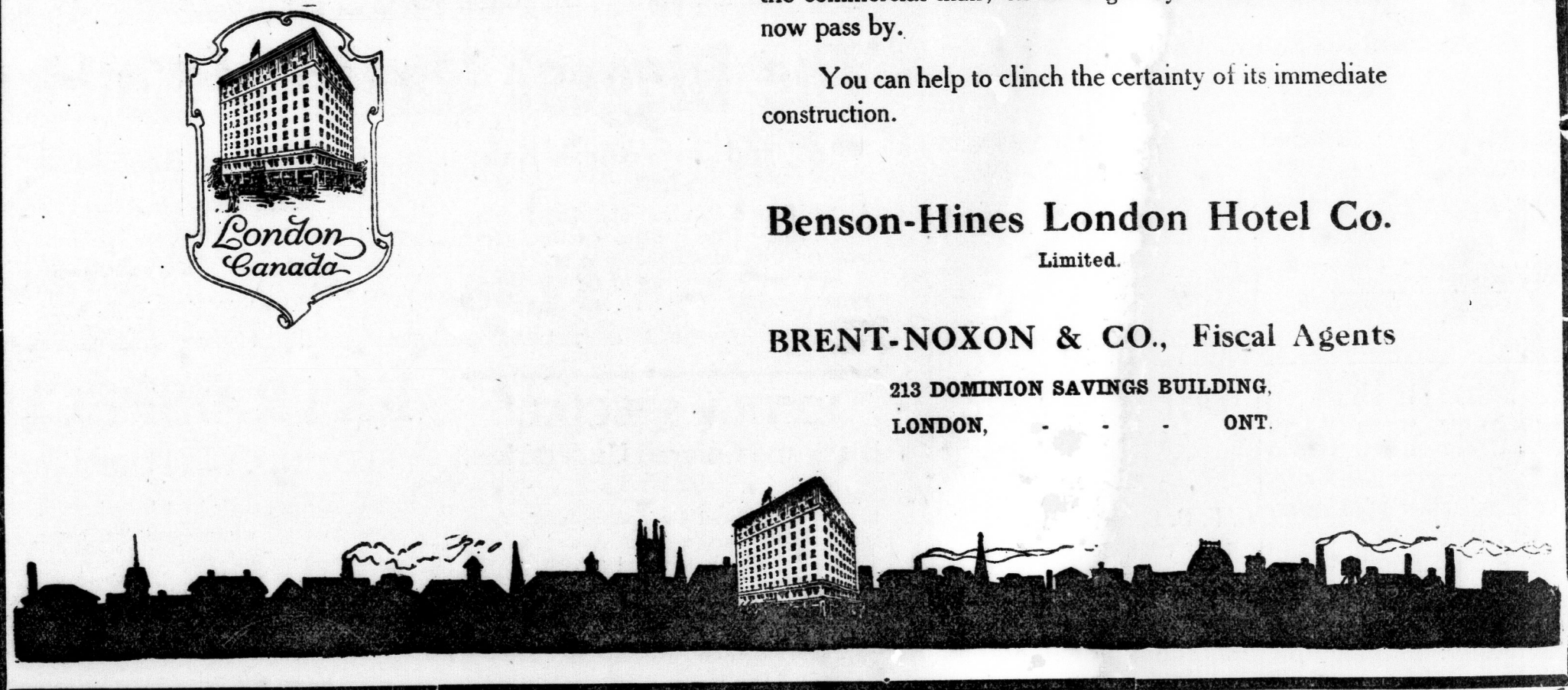
