# COCHRANE LOTS SELL AT HIGH FIGURES

### T. & N. O. Commission Realizes \$50,000 and Many Enterprises Are Protected for G.T.P. Junction.

NORTH BAY, Nov. 27.—(Special.)—A storm blew down the wires on the T. & N. O. last night and held up the World despatch, fled at Matheson's, describing the record-breaking sale of the townsite lots at Cochrane yesterday.
