draw her troops from all parts of Austria, Hungary, Turkey and Persia occupied by her, while the powers of the quadruple alliance will withdraw their troops from Poland in accordance with the principles of the Russian Government.

Free Referendum. "In this connection the presence of any troops, apart from national or local militia, in the territories which are voting shall not be permissible until this question is decided."

Germany then proposed the following form for the first articles of a preliminary treaty which is to be concluded.

"Russia and Germany are to declare the state of war at an end. Both nations are resolved to live together in the future in peace and friendship on the basis of complete reciprocity."

RUSSIAN MOB DESIRES PEACE

(Continued from Page One).

Austrian prisoners of war held in Petrograd, Saturday, for the purpose of organizing an internationalist propaganda among prisoners in Russia.

The Hungarian officer, Rudiniansky, who was elected president, said:

"Thanks to the Russian revolution I can speak my innermost thoughts freely. Our first thought now is general peace and freedom for all nations."

Let Russian freedom teach us to obtain a like freedom at home."

The first speaker, a Czech, made a violent attack upon Count Czernin, the Austro-Hungarian prime minister, who recently outlined the German peace terms at Brest-Litovsk.

characterizing Czernin's program of self-determination within the limits of the Austrian constitution as an imperialistic fraud.

Will Not Fight Allies. "If a separate peace is concluded," he said, "we shall be sent to fight against the Italian, French and other allies. That we will not do. There was a gendarme of Europe, the Russian czar, but he was overpowered. There remains another gendarme, the dynasty of the Hapsburgs and the Hohenzollerns, which too, must be overthrown."

During the meeting Trotsky's official newspaper, the Torch, was distributed freely and eagerly read by the assemblage.

In the course of an interview, Baron Keyserlingk, discussing the details of the enforcement of an armistice in the White Sea and Arctic Ocean, said that the resolution stated that Russia must be protected against submarines.

The Germans asked for three days recess in order to communicate with Berlin before replying.
