

He aid that the depositions showed that Mc-ad, in November last, quarrelled with the prisoner at a house of an Austrian voman, named Marie Hermanchuck, at Jinto. McKay and Pettley had a quant ty of liquor and treated everybody in the house, except Endini, who was a oarder there. 
