SKIRTS BARRIER TO WOMEN'S FREEDOM

War Refugee and Opera Singer to Inaugurate Campaign for Adoption of Trousers

New York, Nov. 16.—The winning of woman suffrage in New York state and a series of accidents due to the wearing of skirts, have decided Miss Wilna Sanda, a war refugee and an opera and concert singer, to attempt to free women from their traditional and impeding hobble.

Miss Sanda believes in hobbles, but one for each leg, and in about three days, when publicity has relieved some of the embarrassment, Miss Sanda expects to lead a parade up Fifth avenue. The parade is not scheduled and a police permit has not yet been obtained. It will be an extemporaneous affair that will form when the men see the new "pants."

However, this woman expects others, in fact, she has the promise of others, to follow suit, so that in time she will be able to appear without blocking the traffic.

The costume in which Miss Sanda, as a grand marshal, will lead the procession, is to consist of black silk Oriental trousers and a sort of Russian coat of the same material. Beneath the coat, which is of the nature of a wrap, she will wear a blouse or shirtwaist. The trousers, called by a French culotte, will be adorned by a swaggar sash, and one of the main reasons for the trousers—four or even five roomy pockets.

The pockets trace their conception back to the time when Miss Sanda, trying to gather up the folds of her skirt,

INCREASED MILK COST IS MENACE TO HEALTH

New Haven, Conn., Nov. 16.—The increased cost of milk by decreasing its use among the class which needs it most for the young has become a direct menace to the health of the community, declares Health Officer Frank W. Wright in a statement made public Wednesday. His compilation of mortality figures for September, he says, shows an unusual number of deaths among infants from digestive ailments.

While admitting that the cost of production has increased, Dr. Wright asserts that the cost to the consumer shows a greater advance than necessary under the conditions and believes both the dealer and producer are getting more for the milk than they should.
