WESLEYAN FEMALE ACADEMY.

For Tuition in each Branch of Study in the Intermediate Department, an additional charge of \$1.50, and in the Collegiate Department of \$3 per Term will be made; but in no case shall the expense for Board &c., and Tuition in the Literary Departments of the Institution, exceed \$165 per annum.

A small sum will be charged each term for Library Fee, and also for general incidentals.

An advance payment of \$45 is required at the commencement of each Term.

Miscellaneous Remarks applicable to both Academies.

All who design to become Students in either Branch of the Institution, should enter, if at all possible, at the commencement of the Term, as the regular classes are then organized; pupils, however, will be received at any time. The only pre-requisites for admission into the Primary Department are a good moral character, ability to read and spell, and age sufficient to enable the pupil to prepare regularly for recitation.

Students in good standing can receive an honourable dismissal from the Institution at the end of the Examination at the termination of any Term, and at no other time, except in special cases.

Parents and guardians are respectively requested to write to the Principal, should they find it necessary to recall a student in Termtime.

Persons who may not wish to pursue either course regularly, will be allowed to enter any of the Classes, in order, for which they are qualified; but where there is no intimation of desire on the part of the parents or guardians of the youthful students, dictating a modified course, they will be examined, and have their places assigned
