TRADE AIR LINE IS SUCCESS.

The Cleveland-Detroit air line, which began operations on July 17, has proved a commercial success and has awakened in the west an interest in the possibilities of aviation, according to the Aeromarine Airways, Inc., which fostered the development. With two eleven-passenger flying cruisers making two flights each day between the two cities, a total of 1,889 passengers and 2,574 pounds of freight were carried in a period ending Sept. 27.

A total of 222 crossings over Lake Erie were accomplished; twenty-eight charter flights were made to points along Lake Erie, Lake St. Clair and Lake Huron. Among the articles of freight carried was a Ford roadster, it was said. Forty-nine per cent. of the patrons during July were women. The company had a 100 per zent. record of performance and there were no forced landings nor mishaps, it was announced.
