FLOODS AND CYCLONES. Storm Sweeps Over Sahara—Train in Middle of Lake.

Bizra, Algeria, Nov. 29.—A cyclone, accompanied by torrential rains, has raged for three days over the region of Sahara between Gheddia, sixty miles south of this city, and Touargourt, the desert railway terminus. The Bizra-Touargourt railway line has been cut in five places by floods, and a train which left here was stalled in the middle of a lake, measuring 100 square kilometers. The passengers, who were rescued, were taken to Djamma, and returned here, their train in some places

100,000 SAILORS IN 1922. Passed Through Port, Says C. C. Hospital Committee.

That no fewer than one hundred thousand sailors have passed through the port of Montreal during the season now ending is stated in the report of a special committee appointed by the Catholic Sailors' Club to visit sick sailors in the Montreal General and Notre Dame Hospitals. Eighteen nationalities were represented by the sailors visited, these including Malays, Italians, English, Irish, Danish, Swedish, Norwegian, Chinese, Maltese, German, Newfoundland, Spanish, Serbian, Arab, French, Russian, Jugo-Slavian and

Ethnion. Letters were written for them by the members of the visiting committee, and they were also supplied with reading matter, fruit and chocolate. In the case of a sick Italian sailor dishes of spaghetti were supplied on several occasions by the visitors.
