**MORNING NEWS OVER THE WIRES**

The counterband cargo carried on the schooner Grace and Ruby exceeded \$800,000 at bootleggers' valuations, Boston authorities estimate after they discovered that she carried twice as much liquor as was shown in her manifest. It is contended that the liquor seized a short time before on the Massachusetts coast was also from this schooner, which, it is alleged, is a mother ship for the rum runners. Captain Ross denies this, however. He is charged with conspiracy to smuggle liquor into the United States.

The schooner Emerald, of Digby, flying the British flag, was seized by the Coast Guard Cutter Manning, nine miles southeast of Cape Charles lighthouse, as a rum runner, on Saturday. Her cargo consisted of more than 1,000 cases of liquor for New York delivery. The captain, J. A. Williams, and his crew were taken into custody. The Emerald was seven days out of Nassau and reported to be bound for St. Pierre.

The executive of district 26, United Mine Workers of America left Truro yesterday for Montreal where they will confer with the officials of the British Empire Steel Corporation in an endeavor to arrive at a wage and working agreement for the Nova Scotia miners. The officials will bring back the best proposition which the corporation will offer and present it to their membership for a vote. The executive were empowered to take this action by the special district convention at Truro.
