TO TRY AGAIN TO END COAL STRIKE

(Canadian Press Dispatch)

London, June 17.—The two-thirds majority required for continuance of the coal stoppage was exceeded by more than 20,000 votes. This came as a complete surprise to all those concerned.

No decision relative to the next move of the miners could be reached at a lengthy conference of the executive of the miners' federation tonight, and adjournment was taken until tomorrow. The chief difficulty facing the miners' officials is the fact that the government time limit within which the state grant of £10,000,000 must be accepted expires tomorrow. They have shown reluctance to lose this grant, and apparently hope to induce the government and mine owners to reopen the negotiations.

FOR AGREEMENT ON DISARMAMENT

(Canadian Press Dispatch)

London, June 17.—In a lengthy editorial, the London Times this morning discussed a despatch from its Washington correspondent interpreting the attitude of the Harding administration and United States opinion, on the general aspects of a plan for a working Anglo-American understanding of world-wide scope, particularly on disarmament. The correspondent declared, in substance, that while Ireland and the apparent unwillingness of this country to apply the principle of equal opportunity in mandated territories were the chief obstacles to a working arrangement between the United States and Great Britain, the first step to that end might be in an agreement to limit expenditures for naval armaments. The despatch suggested the initiative in reaching such an agreement might come from the British side.

VETERANS TO WORK FOR DISARMAMENT

Ottawa, June 17.—A proposal to link up all veteran organizations in every part of the world in an effort to secure world-wide disarmament will be brought before the convention of the Dominion command, Great War Veterans Association, which is to be held at Port Arthur (Ont.) starting July 4, according to reports around G. W. V. A. headquarters here today.

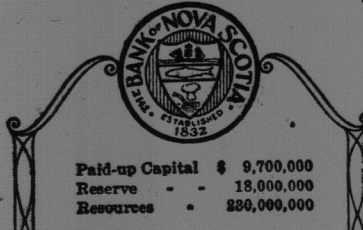
