NEW YORK, May 15.—District Attorney Pecora announced today that a Grand Jury investigation of the "baby farm" conducted in this city by Mrs. Helen Auguste Geison-Volk would be started next Tuesday. Mrs. Seisen-Volk is held in \$36,000 bail on charges of child substitution housing more babies than her license

Records show that 44 babies died in two "baby farms" conducted by her since 1918. The bodies of two babies were exhumed on Wednesday, and it was discovered that William Winters, six months old, had died of the strength of died of a fractured skull and not of congenital heart disease, as was stat-ed on the burial certificate.


