thoroughly mixed and incorporated with the mould, before the plant is inserted. The effect of the lime is to push on the growth of plant in its first and most precarious stage: new fibres begin to form and ramify from the tap-root, and not only is the growth of the plant secured, but it is advanced in a double ratio, compared with the ordinary system where no lime is used. The plants are thriving steadily.
